WEED TO WATCH FOR: Leafy spurge, Euphorbia esula

Leafy spurge is very invasive and hard to get rid of once established. It is on many roadsides in Ogle county and is moved around from mowing.

Leaf drips white sap if you break leaf. Flower is distinct.

Treat with Panoramix which has imazapic as an active ingredient. Look for plants around the flowering ones that are not in flower. There will be several without blooms for every bloom you see. Treat once in summer and return in fall for a very effective kill.

There are a few plants in the savanna planting at the Holland House, near the SW corner of garage. There have been plants on south side of Tellabs pond.
